



# Airport Carbon emissions reduction & sustainability




#### Levels of accreditation



#### **Green Airports Recognition 2022** Carbon Management

ACI Asia-Pacific selected **Carbon Management** as the theme for Green Airports Recognition 2022. The goal is to share and recognize best practices among airports along the decarbonization journey, in particular Scope 1 and Scope 2 **carbon emission reduction**.



Twenty-three eligible GAR 2022 submissions were received from member airports, 12 airports were recognized.
